New Forums Platform - Follow Up

Hi all,

As promised (albeit a wee bit late), I'm following up on our conversation on Tuesday about the introduction of a new forums platform and a reimagined experience on the platform.

Let me set some context for those of you who missed the conversation.

While we wish our users didn't encounter problems with their products, the fact of the matter is that errors, crashes, and other problems do occur. When we have these problems, we search for someone else who already solved our same problem. We're surely not the first person who has had this same barrier and so, we look for our question and some answers that will help us get back to our work quickly. The current forums experience facilitates these question-and-answer based conversations decently and users are able to get in and get out, right back into what they were doing before the problem occurred. However, there are conversations that go untouched and leave some of our members in the dark, with no direction on how to move forward and the sense that they are alone in facing these problems. And so they don't move forward; they give up and feel discouraged.

So, with that in mind, we're going to do several things with this new experience:

- Improve finding conversations that address your search whether you're coming from a search engine like Google or you're on the forums.
- Improve finding conversations that are untouched or have no resolution.
- Improve staying updated with conversations or communities like photography beginners, or InDesign users, or other ACPs.
- Inspire users to seek each other out and the content we contribute.

There are multitudes of ways that we've come up to make the above happen whether it's through the user interface, the content, the forums' tools, etc. But we're looking to you all to help us in choosing what is valuable to the millions of users who read, create, and contribute to this place.

At end of the day, we want to make sure users are:

- 1. finding solutions quicker and more easily,
- 2. learning from each other, especially from experts who spend lots of time on the forums,
- 3. teaching each other,
- 4. discovering and improving on their methods of making things, and finally,
- 5. connecting with each other in ways that make them feel they've found their community, their people

Now - I did mention that I was looking for feedback in the form of looking at some of our very initial wireframes near the end of this week. Our team had some big changes this past week and we want to make sure the effort and time we're asking of you is spent wisely on the correct wireframes. Our designers are working on reflecting these big changes into these wireframes and thus, we'll be sending out an ask to look at them in a couple of weeks. Apologies for the delay - I know how much you all are excited about seeing them. Regardless, I do want to make sure there's value to you all in this update so I'll be using the rest of this post to answer the questions we went over and the ones we didn't get to.

Of course, if there are more questions than what was asked below - please reply with them or see the very end for other ways of contacting me and I'll try to answer them as soon as possible.

Beware though, there are **many** questions below!

Going forward, will the new experience still be on Jive?

No, we're migrating to a different platform product called Lithium. (The company actually used to be of the same name, but they have since changed their name to Khoros. I'll keep referring to them as Lithium.)

Will the new experience support RSS?

Yes. Not at launch but it's something we'll work on bringing back.

Is all the stuff on Jive going to be ported over?

Mostly, some really old content may not make it over.

Is this news of a new forum platform NDA?

At this time, yes. We will let everyone know when this news is available to all users.

With the change in intent, will there be a change in ACP vs. staff involvement?

There are no changes to ACP involvement. Staff involvement will increase.

Is Lithium better than Jive?

We think so - there are many constraints within the Jive platform that have hit us pretty hard in the past couple of years and Lithium provides us greater flexibility even in pretty basic areas of a forums platform product. Additionally, we have a community that is bigger than what Jive can handle. Some of the problems we've seen in speed and performance are directly related to that inability to handle our size.

Will the settings for the forums we are following get ported?

It depends - many settings will get ported over but there are some areas such as what communities you follow that can't be migrated over. We're working with our partnered Lithium team on how to mitigate this gap.

Will we still get emails for the forums we follow?

As mentioned above, we likely won't be able to "remember" what forums you followed on the Jive platform when migrating to the Lithium platform; however, when you follow forum communities on the new platform, you will receive emails for updates to those forum communities.

Are all forums going to make the jump at once?

I previously mentioned in our conversation that we would be phasing this so that

some forum communities would get migrated ahead of others. This is actually one of the big changes that happened this past week. The new answer is: yes, all forums and most of their respective content will be migrated all at once.

Is there an effort to reorganize the forums?

Yes. A lot of the forum communities are based on parent-child relationships where you can post to both the parent space and the child space. Some child-spaces have their own child-spaces. One of the constraints we're working around with this migration is that Lithium's version of a parent space cannot be posted in. Because of that restriction, we'll be reorganizing the forums so that all spaces are rather top-level peers of each other. An example is the Photoshop Scripting sub-space within the Photoshop space. We'll be migrating the content within Photoshop Scripting into the Photoshop space on Lithium but attaching a "Scripting" label so that you'll be able to still filter what you're seeing to only be about scripting with Photoshop.

Maybe this an opportunity to switch from "correct answer" to "best answer"?

Yes, this a great call-out. One of the benefits of migrating to the Lithium platform is the fact that there can be multiple "correct answers" rather than only one. We know that there are many different ways of creating the same output within one product and thus, there are going to be multiple solutions to a question.

UserVoice (for the Photoshop and Lightroom ecosystems) and similar other silos drive fragmentation of the community and confusion about where to go. Is there any plan to fold those platforms into Lithium as well?

We agree that many places exist today within the overall Adobe support ecosystem and that it's really fracturing the community of users. At launch, we won't be making improvements in folding those places into Lithium but it is a longer-term goal. We want to emphasize that the community that will exist on the Lithium platform is the Adobe support destination where users can ask questions of each other and connect with each other.

Is the Lithium platform is Java based? What makes it perform better and faster than the current platform?

Yes, and there's some MySQL used to implement server-side functionality. Without getting into a list of things - overall the biggest thing contributing to Lithium performing better and faster is the fact that it's had consistent developer attention and steady updates to the platform, something that the team behind Jive was not able to provide. I've seen steady updates to the platform for the past several year happen around every half of a year.

So there will be a single forum per product?

Mostly yes - each product will have their own forum community and we also think there's room for non-product based forum communities, for example, Embark.

Since Embark is brand new and Lithium is brand new, maybe start Lithium with the two new Embark forums?

That's a great suggestion that our team, coincidentally, was in the middle of finalizing earlier in the week. Now that the plan to migrate forum communities in groups has changed to migrating all forum communities at launch - this won't happen. But we'll keep this mind if that plan changes.

Will we still be able to use our email clients to respond to threads?

Yes, you will!

If the forum is "first and foremost" for support, will there be more participation from experts employed by Adobe or will it continue to be "couched" as a user and volunteer medium?

As mentioned previously, Adobe staff participation and involvement will increase; however, we want members to continue to have more and more conversations with each other so that they're learning from each other and teaching each other. A longer-term goal is to get more of the employees who actually sit on the respective product teams to participate here. We'll work on balancing that type of increased participation without stymying newer users from contributing to conversations where they feel they can input.

Can we keep our points rating hidden from the public in our badges?

Part of the reason why I think this question is important is the why behind it. Points often have no helpful meaning to the users we interact with. Users probably don't care that someone has 1000 more points than the other person who answered their questions. But they might care if they knew this person was an expert at Photoshop versus Premiere Rush. So, there won't be points on Lithium because a rank structure will replace it. David has been actively working on a framework that preserves all the amazing work you've done and translates that into a rank structure that retains participation and engagement over the years. Points that have been accrued will be maintained and factored into this structure with various titles.

Will there be any app implementation? I really think this would be great because lots of users aren't always at our desktop computers.

If app implementation means mobile apps for iOS, Android, etc. devices, no. We won't be focusing on a mobile app at all. However, a mobile app is just one way of providing users a way to access the communities on their mobile devices. We will be focusing on improving the mobile experience of the forums. If app implementation means integrated with our products and other Adobe services, then yes, it's another one of our longer-term goals.

Is it going to be more like the Education Forum?

We're working with that group to try to maintain a connection. Right now, the eLearning team has created a Wordpress skin that's access Jive via API. All of the conversations live on Jive but they have a much more pleasant-to-look-at interface. We're working with them as part of the transition plan.

I am sort of squeezed between the Jive forums and questions in the eLearning Community...some synching, not complete. Will that remain the same?

As mentioned above, we're working with the eLearning group to get them ported over in the new experience.

What's the point of points and rankings?

There's a lot of science that's gone into gamification. Ranking and badging contribute to motivating users to come back to the community and spend time beyond initial visits. Historically we've seen many users are one-and-done. They show up, ask a question, get an answer to their question via email because they're auto-subscribed to their own conversation, and move on. What we're trying to do is to make that initial experience a really positive one and to hit some of the triggers we see in the gaming industry or other communities of a reward that provides some rush of fun. The idea is to build a community of active users that is greater than the one we have right now.

In our profiles, we can see our content and filter it but not easily search it. Will the new system help with that? I'd like to be able to find a post more easily to link to it and possibly sort it and post that link with my best responses to LinkedIn.

This is a great suggestion. At release, no, but I'll let our team know about this and we can investigate some more about feasibility.

Will moderators still be able to add forum start page info such as bug fixes/update bulletins, etc.?

Our community managers and administrators will still be able to create posts similarly to what's been occurring in the Embark communities today and additionally, feature those posts so that users discover it very easily when viewing each forum community.

Will linked tutorials that exist on Jive be ported?

If the linked tutorial was created as a post, it will be migrated over. However, if you're referring to linked tutorials that show up on some forum overview pages now, those will not be migrated over. However, each community's lead will be able to create a post about that tutorial and feature it as mentioned earlier in this answer.

Are you looking at active communities on Slack, Facebook, for assistance, modeling?

Yes! Facebook is one of the many platforms we reviewed in early stages of ideation. Slack has come up multiple times in internal phases of user research as well. The other communities/platforms we reviewed in ideation are Apple Support Communities, Airbnb Community, American Express' OPEN Forum, YouTube, Salesforce Trailblazers, TalkTalk, Alteryx, Sephora, Spotify, Microsoft, Reddit, and Discourse.

Will the new platform have a live chat feature?

Live chat on conversations is not something Lithium currently supports. Live chat between users is also not supported. However, our team can investigate the value behind this thought for a future goal.

Can we have a time scheduled for training on the new platform ahead of time so we can plan to attend?

Yes, Tricia and I will work on scheduling something for you all to attend.

Will you allow feedback from ACPs about performance, etc.? How do we stay in touch with the developers?

Of course! That's one of the reasons why I wanted to set a time to chat with you all. Tuesday's conversation was the start of a relationship I plan to keep with you all. I (along with some others from the team) will keep popping in here to keep in communication with you. Feel free to always @mention me on here, private message me, send an email (see down below), or send an owl.

Will mentoring be incorporated?

I believe this is referring to one of the initiatives Tricia has communicated with you all previously. I'll be working with Tricia to get up to date on what's been discussed thus far.

Will we need a prescription to log on to Lithium?

I'm not exactly sure what this means...I assume an account. Yes, you'll need an account and the good news is that account will be your Adobe ID. So, there's no need to create a new account or anything of the sort.

When can we get a sneak peak of the UI?

As mentioned above, our designers are working on reflecting some big changes that happened since Tuesday's conversations into the wireframes. I'll be posting this update in a couple of weeks.

Is there an area where we can ask for new functionality?

We'll be treating this new experience and platform as its own product and with that, comes release notes and an area to talk about this product. That forum community will be where you can ask for new functionality. If you'd like to make a suggestion now so that we consider it after the first release, feel free to comment with it!

I see a need to have standard responses - legally - that we use for answers that come up like

doing something for the customer that is not allowed i.e. a clear view of car license plate to catch traffic violation, etc.

Good suggestion – I've submitted this as another item for our team to investigate for after release.

Can we keep to one main topic per discussion?

The Lithium platform will have the same ability to branch threads as Jive does today. Additionally, community managers will be able to merge threads. That's as much as the platform can offer to help with this topic as of right now. We may be able to set some placeholder text when replying. Again, I'll investigate with the team.

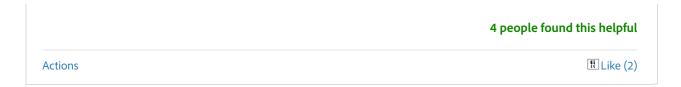


Thank you so much, Melissa – this is very helpful! So glad to hear it is finally happening...

Here are a few > sorry, some, initial considerations.

Is all the stuff on Jive going to be ported over?

Mostly, some really old content may not make it over.

I hope you will do the utmost to have as much as possible ported over, because the old stuff is still a wealth worth keeping, and using.

At least in the Illustrator forum, there are regularly answers that link back to old threads, many of those going back to threads from the days before the Jive forums started in 2009; in those days threads died after a certain time of inactivity (when I realized that in 2004 I started building an archive and a few years later I started reposting in some especially important threads to keep them alive), so the Jive forums brought a definite improvement.

I hope the new forums will also keep keeping old threads until all questions have been answered, or till the end of days, whichever occurs first.

Is there an effort to reorganize the forums?

Yes. A lot of the forum communities are based on parent-child relationships where you can post to both the parent space and the child space. Some child-spaces have their own child-spaces. One of the constraints we're working around with this migration is that Lithium's version of a parent space cannot be posted in. Because of that restriction, we'll be reorganizing the forums so that all spaces are rather top-level

peers of each other. An example is the Photoshop Scripting sub-space within the Photoshop space. We'll be migrating the content within Photoshop Scripting into the Photoshop space on Lithium but attaching a "Scripting" label so that you'll be able to still filter what you're seeing to only be about scripting with Photoshop.

Can you use a filter or something on what will correspond to the Discussion pages and avoid unwanted threads corresponding to those in the subspaces, or will all threads about one application (such as Photoshop or Illustrator) always appear together so it is necessary to bypass all the subspace threads by looking at labels?

If the latter, I believe that to be a serious setback in efficiency when answering (and undoubtedly when looking for answers). As it is already, it is hard to keep up with the relentless appearance of new threads to consider answering.

Maybe this an opportunity to switch from "correct answer" to "best answer"?

Yes, this a great call-out. One of the benefits of migrating to the Lithium platform is the fact that there can be multiple "correct answers" rather than only one. We know that there are many different ways of creating the same output within one product and thus, there are going to be multiple solutions to a question.

This is a definite improvement, provided it is (predominantly) limited to present equally right/complete/manageable solutions.

Hopefully, helpful answers that may contribute to a solution can still be marked as such.

Can we keep our points rating hidden from the public in our badges?

Part of the reason why I think this question is important is the why behind it. Points often have no helpful meaning to the users we interact with. Users probably don't care that someone has 1000 more points than the other person who answered their questions. But they might care if they knew this person was an expert at Photoshop versus Premiere Rush. So, there won't be points on Lithium because a rank structure will replace it. David has been actively working on a framework that preserves all the amazing work you've done and translates that into a rank structure that retains participation and engagement over the years. Points that have been accrued will be maintained and factored into this structure with various titles.

I hope you will consider the lowest possible degree of ranking, as few titles as possible.

Ultimately, the quality of answers is all that matters to those seeking help, and that may be best judged without any bias caused by ranking which may have no more helpful meaning than have points; from quiet observation over the past decade with points and most of it with badges I am convinced there is a certain bias inherent in a community with ranking; also some of those giving some of the best answers based on profound insight and skills have few points and/or no badge and would therefore be low in a high degree ranking.

I believe the strongest possible community is one as close as possible to a community of equals.

All that said, my observations over the last decade (and comparison with all the years that went before) have (slowly) convinced me that a certain ranking of answers (by marking) and of those giving them (by badges/points/whatever (once we had forum top contributors)) forms part of optimizing the overall forum qualities; I believe it may be a delicate balance.

Apologizing for my carrying on, an elaboration on the answer marking:

Yestreen I came across a new (at least to me) abbreviation, TO, which I believe can only mean Thread Owner, which I really like because I believe in the unlimited right of the TO/OP (Original Poster) to decide which post(s) to mark as correct/best and also change such post markings. There are also the special issues with the Assumed Correct answer marking, if that option will also be there in the future (I for one hope not).

Sometimes, TOs gets it wrong (in which case anyone is free to point it out, which will also add to the sharing of knowledge), but so do moderators and staff. Also, in quite a few cases, the initial question is woolly or worse, and the actual question/issue is only revealed if the thread is allowed to take its course.

Crucial to the TO right to decide is opportunity.

One of my (other) observations over the last decade have convinced me that many TOs,

maybe especially newcomers, are very reluctant to change a correct/best answer (or an Assumed Answered) marking made by moderators/staff, even when obviously/seemingly disagreeing with it; quite likely this is a matter of respect for authority.

I appreciate the great effort made by moderators and staff to make sure that as many threads as possible can be marked for the benefit of everyone looking for answers, even going back months and years.

But I believe that the TO should always have a reasonable time to consider and make markings first, maybe a week or two, or at least over the weekend when answers have been given late in the week. Just as the helpers can be busy, the TOs can have to do something else before returning to their threads.

So I would suggest a general holding of horses to start with.

But I believe it is also important that it is easy for the TO to change markings. At least in the present version of the forums it is quite difficult, especially for newcomers, to find out how to make such changes; it has been up recently that it has even proved difficult for moderators to undo an Assumed Answered marking.

Therefore I hope that the new forums will make it much simpler and easier to find out how to and change markings (including Assumed Answered), also for newcomers.

All this in order to best ensure the right markings, rather than to have the best answers hidden/overlooked owing to inexpedient markings.

Hi Jacob Bugge,

No need for apologies - I appreciate hearing from you all about this transition!

Thank you so much for setting up the context to problem you've observed over the past. You bring up a very good point that newcomers to the forums wouldn't be sure about how to move the status of Correct Answer to another reply that actually helped them out let alone know how to mark a reply as the correct answer unless we communicate how to do that in a very easy and intuitive way.

A few other things - Assumed Answered won't be an option for conversation threads in the future. But we will have reminders to original posters after a set amount of time about coming back to the thread, especially if there are replies. Those reminders will be prime opportunities for us to remind all users, especially new ones about the option of marking a reply as a correct answer and why it helps the community overall. Presently, I believe there is a suggested hold time of around 3 days for new posts before marking anything as correct,

unless the original poster. But again, I believe that's just a suggestion.

Lastly, I'm curious about the abbreviation "TO" that you're seeing. If you could show me where you're seeing that, I'd be interested in knowing. I haven't seen that used anywhere on the forums yet, but maybe I'm looking in the wrong places.

By the way, that thread is also relevant to the matters of hold time/reminders: as you can see from the thread, it was marked very appropriately by a moderator (Ares, just before his own answer (I can see that in my Inbox)), 6 days after the OP, 4 work days (fully in accordance with the current suggested hold time), and Ken (the OP/TO) never returned (so far at least).

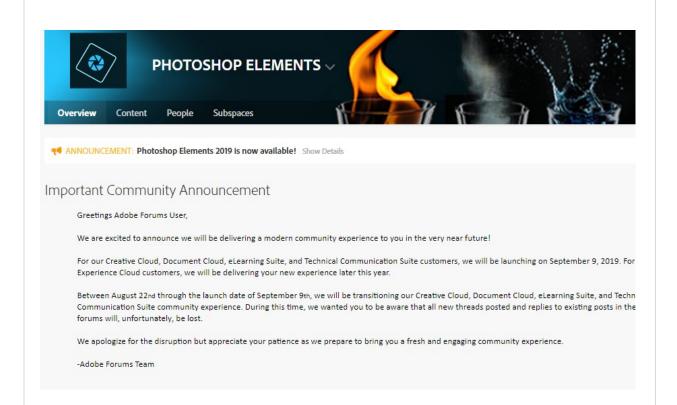

Follow up thoughts regarding today's BlueJeans session:

- BlueJeans is quite bad. It enables the audio and video of every participant who joins a session by default, which causes constant distractions and annoyances. In the future, the invites should include instructions on how to mute the audio and video in the application before joining the session, or at least as soon as possible after doing so. Also, the chat window scroller is pretty annoying, as it keeps jumping by itself to the bottom whenever a

5 of 18 31/12/2022, 23:42 new message is posted, making it difficult to follow the discussions. I think Dave missed quite a few key questions in today's session (due to no fault of his own) because of these issues.

- I predict that the new forums are going to be quite chaotic during the first couple of days/weeks. The structure will be completely different to what it is now and with no subforums the pages for large products like Acrobat, Photoshop, InDesign, etc. are going to be flooded with hundreds of questions on a variety of subjects, and the experts won't be able to follow up on everything. A lot of questions are going to remain unanswered for a long time. (I'm not going to be around for the first couple of weeks after the launch, thankfully)
- "Topics" (not tags!) are not enough to keep track of the various subjects and it was never made clear who will be in charge of adding these topics, and who will apply them to new questions. If the users, then forget about it. It's not going to happen. Is Adobe expecting us to do it? That will be a huge amount of work, and I doubt most ACPs, MVPs, and other experts are going to bother with it.

Also, it's not clear to me if the topics are just generic ones like "Scripting" or will they be more specific like "Acrobat Scripting" or "Digital Signature in PDF files", etc. If they're not specific and can't be used for filtering with multiple terms (eg. "Acrobat" + "Scripting" + "Annotations", or something like that) they will be useless.

- It seems a lot of time and effort (and certainly money) was spent on the cosmetics and the "gamification" of the forums, as opposed to their functionality. It's nice to be able to insert mp4 videos and attach files of up to 50MB to each message, but if at the end of the day we can't follow the discussions because only 4 fit in the window at a time and there are 300 barely related new messages under a single forum every day (because it's a catch-all for everything PS-related), that's not good. Also, those "badges" are nice trinkets, but should not be a part of a serious platform. What about RSS feeds? What about email subscriptions to specific issues? A searchable archive of past threads? etc.

Sorry about the long rant, and maybe I'm completely wrong about all of this... Would love to hear the opinions of others, too.

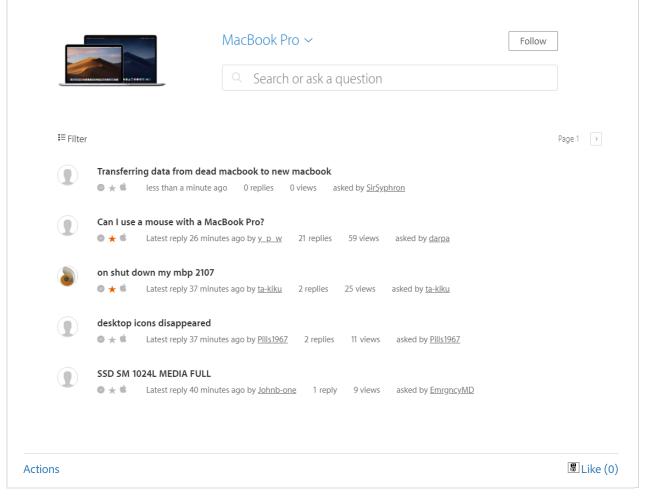

- 1. The default sort order for listing the forums in the landing page is by "Popular." While this may seem great if you're looking for Photoshop, it's not great if you're looking for something that isn't in the top 5. You get a long, unsorted list and have to hunt through it. IMHO, "Alphabetical" as the default would be far more useful.
- 2. The check boxes to "narrow" the selection, actually expand it somewhat. If I enable "Photography," for example, I get many more choices than without it enabled. It's like the check boxes are there to "show me the ones I'm looking for" rather than "filter," as the section is titled:

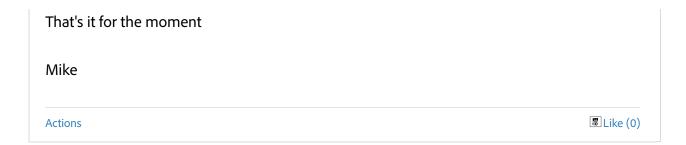


3. Changing the sort order gives inconsistent results, it's not obvious if/when anything is happening, and in some cases it seemed to be updating right in front of my eyes after 15-20 seconds. 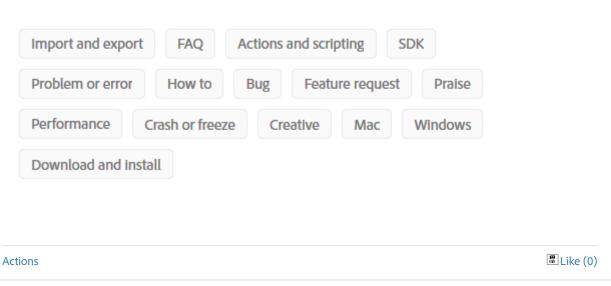

If there are 3 real replies and then a threaded reply to the first real reply then 1, 2, 3 threaded replies to the 2nd or third real reply then some one make a brand new threaded reply to the first threaded reply you could skip right by it. I don't Hate much but I hate going to the Adobe PS/LR Family site because of the threaded replies. I'll get a email saying there is an update to one I have replied to and it takes me a lot more time trying to find the newest post. New replies to any thread should be at the top of the list of topic titles and descending by date and time. Not that way now, maybe a bug.

I don't see any discussion of this point, so I'm going to put this out here. The new forums may be a chance to fix a problem, or may not have the problem.

In the Jive forums, Jive knows our real name and our screen name (nickname). Mine are different, most people's are. Jive show the screen name unless you have a right to see the real name, in which case it shows the real name, with no comment. There are two bad consequences of this, one of them potentially a legal/privacy issue.

- 1. Customers reread their own posts and see their own name. We regularly see users who BELIEVE that their privacy has been exposed/ignored. They are mistaken, but upset.
- 2. When a privileged user (e.g. some staff) replies, they see only the real name and not the nickname. If the reply politely refer to a poster's name, it will therefore be the REAL name. So privileged users will often expose personal names and info because they have no way to avoid it! This happens to me quite often, and it's very annoying (that is, replies use my real name). This may be a serious breach of privacy. In such a case I believe the forum software should show only the nickname, with privileged users having the option to look up both names.

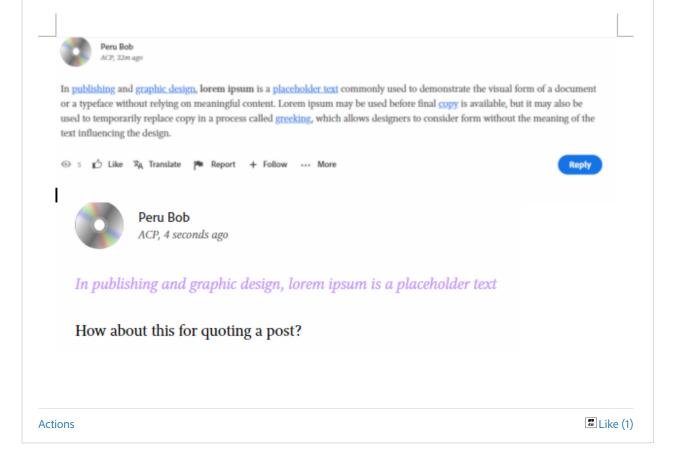

At least in the Illustrator forum we have always had sayings to the effect that there are always multiple ways of doing things (well a bit exaggerated, often being a bit more accurate), so (often) more than one correct answer.

Thanks for the feedback, Just Shoot Me. There are definitely assumptions we made that led to the introduction of new features and the deprecation of older ones. We'll be watching the usage and interaction of features including threaded replies to understand what

improvements can be made.

Our team had some long discussions on some of the very points you brought up. What will be live is the direction we ended up deciding upon; however, I want to reiterate that these directions were again based on hypotheses we wanted to test to ensure that we're delivering value to users finding answers and to all of you helping users. I hear your concerns and we will keep working to iterate on the day one experience.

I would like to understand a bit more from your perspective, and anyone else who wants to chime in, about the first point you made. We thought in depth about the decision to show a two-line preview of the original post to users and originally, did not have the preview there. However, as we tested internally, we often found that original subjects of posts weren't helpful enough to understand what the question might be. I think we've all seen lengthy and poorly described problems in titles. Another option was to only show the two-line preview for all of you, ACPs and MVPs, so that you all had an increased ability to understand what the question might be asking. Based on your feedback above, it looks like both of those assumptions may be wrong but I'd definitely like to understand if you think the bigger problem to solve here is motivating better-described titles or accepting titles as poor as they can be and showing previews of the original posts.

Anyway, thank you again for your in-depth feedback! I'm looking to forward to hearing more from you and everyone else who has provided valuable comments on how we can improve.

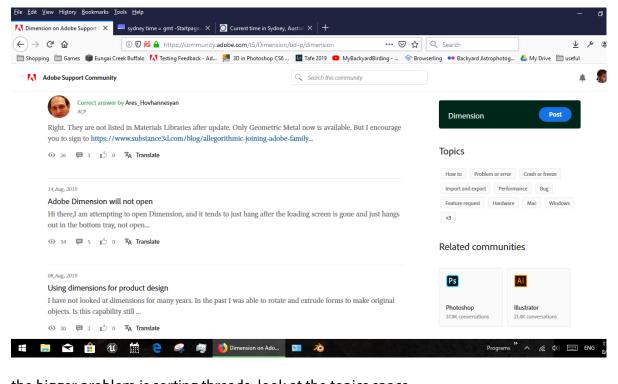

I think we've all seen lengthy and poorly described problems in titles. Another option was to only show the two-line preview for all of you, ACPs and MVPs, so that you all had an increased ability to understand what the question might be asking.

Like the others, two line previews do not help me at all. They actually have the opposite effect. They rarely give any further insight into the real question being asked - in fact, they're more likely to reveal more irrelevant words and circumstantial points, thereby wasting screen real estate and forcing lots of scrolling and page turning due to less posts per page view.

The real question is often in the 2nd or 3rd paragraph - and poorly worded.

I prefer the current Jive UI: as many questions on the screen as possible (Compact View) with Mods having the ability to edit the subject line to make it more succinct and accurate. I'm happy doing that and I find that the responses to the post often increase noticeably after a subject line has been edited and clarified.

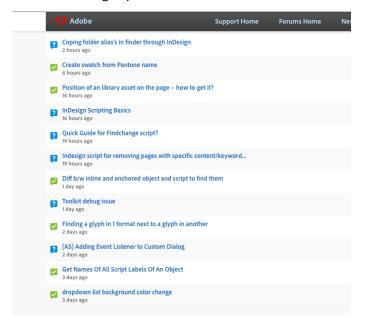

- A) View as PDF and download (this thread has no such option), which is the poorest representation without post numbers and markings, and images linked from external sources may be truncated or missing altogether; these PDFs are simply named by thread number;
- B) Ctrl/Cmd+P and print as PDF, with post numbers and markings, still images linked from external sources may be truncated or missing altogether; these PDFs are named by title, but you can see the thread number/post number;
- C) RightClick then save as Web Page, complete, which gives exactly the same appearance as in the forums; the thread number/post number is hidden away in the page source I believe.

Aided by a set of Bookmarks, I have kept updating the saved contents to include new posts.

Up to now, I am saving contents from 27 threads including this one.

For anyone wishing to do the same, it is crucial to remember that in multipage threads like this one, each page must be saved separately whichever way is used; to illustrate, I am printing/saving this 5th page as PDF under the name New Forums Platform - Follow Up _ Adobe Community - 5.

First day of new forum for me, logged in the Captivate forum as I do daily and am worried. Normally I get notifications of all new questions, but that is no longer the case. I checked and there was only ONE question today which is what worries me. During the presentation of the forum, I asked where to find the Captivate forum, had to look for it myself and it is only available under the filter 'PRINT and pulbishing'. As a Captivate newbie I would never look under print at all, because Captivate creates interactive video, to be deployed on the web. It is related very much with video tools (many users indciate Captivate output as video) web tools, even dseign, but never with Print. It has to be confirmed but putting Captivate (and Prime which is even more crazy) under Print only iis not at all user intuitive.
